1. Charles de Fere Cuvee Jean Louis Blanc de Blancs Brut NV

Made using the same method as Champagne. This wine has an enticing pale gold colour with especially elegant, fine bubbles and a light, crisp taste *Bottle - £22.50*

2. Jeio, Prosecco Rosé, Italy – Delicate pink colour with a complex nose with rose notes, hints of fresh fruit, citrus & lychees.

3. Jeio, Prosecco Brut NV, Italy – Vivacious aromas of wild flowers & almonds balanced by crisp acidity.

5. Perrier Jouet Grand Brut NV – An elegant Champagne with a light & youthful bouquet & an excellent finish.

6. Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin – The Widow, Madame Clicquot Ponsardin developed this, the first sediment free Champagne. *Bottle - £49.50*

7. Laurent Perrier Rosé Cuveé – Pale salmon pink with a fine mousse and delicate berry aromas showing an elegant finish. *Bottle - £70.00*

8. Perrier Jouet Rosé NV – A weightier rose style with strawberry and apple, but still dry.

9. Perrier Jouet Vintage 1998 – An attractive presence of smoky fruit, really nice creamy style with a firmly composed palate. *Bottle - £65.00*

10. Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque 1999 – Superb richness of flavour with honey and brioche. Truly Stunning! *Bottle - £125.00*

11. Dom Perignon 2002 - This cuvee of Moët Chandon is named after the monk who was the most important influence in the development of the wine. *Bottle - £135.00*

12. Louis Roederer - Cristal 2004 – An intensely floral bouquet fragrant with almonds, hazelnuts and wild flowers is complemented by a touch of acidity to mark a finish of elegant persistence. Light and fresh, this is undoubtedly Champagne of admirable magnitude *Bottle - £200.00*

13. Wandering Bear, Zinfandel Rosé 2009 - California – A slightly sweet easy drinking rosé with raspberry & watermelon hints.

51. Chianti Classico- Campomaggio 2007, Italy - Juicy black cherries, blackberries, cinnamon spice, vanilla and chocolate abound. The ripe, bold tannins and crisp Sangiovese acidity add the all important backbone.

52. St Emilion Grand Cru – Chateau Lamartre 2007- France - This spicy, blackcurrant, full-bodied wine reveals dry tannins, fruit and richness.
